Critically discuss the extent to which the decision in Axa General Insurance v Lord Advocate [2011] UKSC 46 has resulted in an increase in public interest litigation in Scotland.

Question 3

Critically assess the extent to which the Tribunals (Scotland) Act 2014 has resulted in increased access to justice for Scottish citizens

Question 4

- b) What further reforms could be made to the second chamber to increase its accountability? (10)
