Clause 1, page 1, line 8	after “office” insert “as detailed in clause 3(3)”
Clause 2, page 15, line 14	add at end “(b) The relevant article can be retained only for a maximum period not exceeding 7 days.”
Clause 3, page 2, line 24	<p>add at the beginning “(3) The functions of the Commander are to</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">a. Uphold the security of the United Kingdom borderb. Enforce the laws enacted by Parliament concerning the security of the United Kingdom borderc. Establish and maintain a “Border Security Board” to assist the Commander in the exercise of these functions.”
Clause 6, page 4, line 23	leave out “a board” and insert “the Border Security Board (referred to in this Act as the “Board”).
Clause 6, page 5, line 12	leave out subsection (2)
Clause 8, page 5, line 29	leave out “thinks” and insert “knows”
Clause 8, page 5, line 35	after “to” insert “suitably qualified”
Clause 9, page 6, line 14	add at end (3) The Secretary of State must consult such persons as the Secretary of State considers appropriate before issuing or revising directions or guidance under this section.”

Clause 21, page 15, line 16	after “it” insert “and in any event no later than the 14 th day after which it was seized”.
Clause 38(1), page 31, line 3	leave out “58” and insert “59”
Clause 41, page 32, Line 23	leave out clause 41
Clause 53, page 55, line 14	add at end –“(3) The Secretary of State may only make regulations under subsection (1) which amend, repeal or revoke an enactment contained in, or in an instrument made under, an Act of the Scottish Parliament with the consent of the Scottish Ministers.”
