Outline and discuss the controls which are in place to ensure that the Scottish Parliament legislates in accordance with the European Convention of Human Rights. (20 marks)

Question 4

a) Outline and discuss the role and functions of the Parliamentary and Health Service Ombudsman (PHSO). Are there any areas in which the Ombudsman could be reformed? (20 marks)
